- 2) Fulfill the general requirements stated under University Regulations (see "Special Honors" in the GWU Undergraduate Bulletin online at: http://www.gwu.edu/~bulletin/ugrad/unrg.html)
- 3) Submit an honors application to the Psychology Department <u>before</u> the start of the student's senior year.
- 4) Complete the Psychology Honors Seminar (PSYC 4197)
- 5) Complete a 8000-level course
- 6) Complete and independent study project (PSYC 4191 or 4198) with a B+ or higher.
- 7) Maintain a grade-point average in GWU psychology courses of 3.5 or higher and an overall GWU GPA of 3.0 or higher.
